7. Reference to the Application of Scholarship Link within the attached scholarship handbook (article 2.1), an applicant needs to fill out pages: 1,7, and 8 only (skip others)
8. Once an applicant is approved, verified, and accepted, he will receive an official email from the admission office to fill out the university online admission application
9. The admission office will send an official email to the accepted student notifying them that the process of issuing the student visa is in progress
